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QUALIFICATION – Certificate IV in Disability CHC43115

This qualification reflects the role of workers in a range of community settings and clients' homes, who provide training and support in a manner that empowers people with disabilities to achieve greater levels of independence, self-reliance, community participation and wellbeing. Workers promote a person-centred approach, work without direct supervision and may be required to supervise and/or coordinate a small team.

To achieve this qualification, the candidate must have completed at least 120 hours of work as detailed in the Assessment Requirements of the units of competency.

Train4Life limit the number of courses we commence and the number of students we accept for each course.

Train4Life use a blended approach towards learning embedding face-to-face classes, gathering of workplace evidence, supporting documentation and online assessments.

Classes:

Students are required to attend all face-to-face classes. Classes are where the quality learning takes place, facilitating in-depth discussions on current practices, industry issues and future industry trends.

Assessment:

Students are required to complete assessment modules online. Each module has a targeted submission due date and it is expected that students will follow the submission timeframes. Completion date for all assessment work is 30 days after the final class.

All students will require access to a computer and the internet to complete online assessments

Third Party Reports:

It is a requirement of the course that you organise completion of four (4) Third Party Reports (template provided by Train4Life) by an appropriate industry representative.

Your third party reports may be completed by a past or present co-worker, supervisor or someone with good knowledge of your skills and experiences.

Prior experience:

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) is available to those with significant industry experience and appropriate evidence.

Examples of evidence may include previously completed qualifications and/or statements of attainment, certificate of attendance for workshops/professional development sessions, workplace training records and position descriptions for relevant jobs.

Please note:

All assessments, including supporting documentation, must be submitted within 30 days of the final face-to-face class.

Assessment extensions of an additional 30 days may be requested at a fee of \$150.00

Students who have not completed their course work by the agreed date will receive a statement of attainment for the units completed.

Train4Life will not release certificates, including statements of attainment, to the students until the student fee is paid in full
